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**SPECIFICATIONS**

1. **PURPOSE AND SCOPE:** The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is soliciting bids on behalf of to establish an open-end contract for compact tractors.
2. **DEFINITIONS:** The terms listed below shall have the meanings assigned to them below. Additional definitions can be found in section 2 of the General Terms and Conditions.
  - 2.1 **“Contract Item” or “Contract Items”** means the list of items identified in Agency 3.1 below and on the Pricing Pages.
  - 2.2 **“Pricing Pages”** means the schedule of prices, estimated order quantity, and totals contained in wvOASIS or attached hereto as Exhibit A, and used to evaluate the Solicitation responses.
  - 2.3 **“Solicitation”** means the official notice of an opportunity to supply the State with goods or services that is published by the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.
  - 2.4 **"PTO Engine Horsepower"** means the horsepower measured at the tractor's power take off.
  - 2.5 **"Gross Engine Horsepower"** means the rating which the engine manufacturer gives an engine as it relates to the engine's maximum output under ideal conditions.
  - 2.6 **"Hydro-static Transmission"** is a system in which power is generated and transmitted by pressurizing and releasing fluid through specialized pumps, also known as a "continuously variable transmission."
  - 2.7 **"Open Center Hydraulic System"** is a system that, when in neutral, connects all lines directly back to the reservoir, bypassing the pump and allowing a constant flow of oil without building up pressure.
  - 2.8 **Mechanical Rear Differential Lock"** is a device that locks both rear wheels together on a common shaft, forcing them to turn in unison.
  - 2.9 **“Quick Attach Method”** means an attachment front or interface that stays permanently attached to your primary machine, enabling you to quickly and easily connect other tools or accessories to the front of the tractor.
  - 2.10 **“ROPS”** means rollover protection structure, intended to protect equipment operators and motorists from injuries caused by vehicle overturns or rollovers.

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**3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

**3.1 Contract Items and Mandatory Requirements:** Vendor shall provide Agency with the Contract Items listed below on an open-end and continuing basis. Contract Items must meet or exceed the mandatory requirements as shown below.

- 3.1.1.5 Must have an open center hydraulic system with a gear pump with a minimum of six (6) gallons per minute flow and one rear valve.
- 3.1.1.6 Must have a category one (1) three-point hitch.
- 3.1.1.7 Must have a four-wheel drive (mechanical front wheel drive) front axle.
- 3.1.1.8 Must have power steering.
- 3.1.1.9 Must have mechanical wet disc brakes.
- 3.1.1.10 Must have mechanical rear differential lock.
- 3.1.1.11 Must have a two-post foldable ROPS.
- 3.1.1.12 Tractor must weigh a minimum of fourteen hundred (1,400) pounds with ROPS and without fluid in tires or other additional weights.
- 3.1.1.13 Must have industrial type tires:
  - 3.1.1.13.1 Tires must be properly weighted with methanol.

- 3.1.1.20 Height to pin must be a minimum of sixty (60) inches.
- 3.1.1.21 Clearance with dumped bucket must be a minimum of forty-eight (48) inches.
- 3.1.1.22 Dump reach must be a minimum of twenty-three (23) inches.

**4. CONTRACT AWARD:**

- 4.1 **Contract Award:** The Contract is intended to provide the Agency with a purchase price on all Contract Items. The Contract shall be awarded to the Vendor that provides the Contract Items meeting the required specifications for the lowest overall total cost as shown on the Pricing Pages.
- 4.2 **Pricing Pages:** Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages by entering a unit price for each item listed in the Pricing Page. Vendor should complete the Pricing Pages in their entirety as failure to do so may result in Vendor’s bids being disqualified.

The Pricing Pages contain a list of the Contract Items and estimated purchase volume. The estimated purchase volume for each item represents the approximate volume of anticipated purchases only. No future use of the Contract or any individual item is guaranteed or implied.

**5. ORDERING AND PAYMENT:**

- 5.1 Ordering:** Vendor shall accept orders through wvOASIS, regular mail, facsimile, e-mail, or any other written form of communication. Vendor may, but is not required to, accept on-line orders through a secure internet ordering portal/website. If Vendor has the ability to accept on-line orders, it should include in its response a brief description of how the Agency may utilize the on-line ordering system. Vendor shall ensure that its on-line ordering system is properly secured prior to processing Agency orders on-line.
- 5.2 Payment:** Vendor shall accept payment in accordance with the payment procedures of the State of West Virginia.

**6. DELIVERY AND RETURN:**

- 6.2 Late Delivery:** The Section placing the order under this Contract must be notified in writing if orders will be delayed for any reason. Any delay in delivery that could cause harm to an Agency will be grounds for cancellation of the delayed order, and/or obtaining the items ordered from a third party.

Any Section seeking to obtain items from a third party under this provision must first obtain approval of the Chief Procurement Officer.

- 6.3 Delivery Payment/Risk of Loss:** Standard order delivery shall be F.O.B. destination to the Agency's location. Vendor shall include the cost of standard order delivery charges in its bid pricing/discount and is not permitted to charge the Agency separately for such delivery. The Agency will pay delivery charges on all emergency orders provided that Vendor invoices those delivery costs as a separate charge with the original freight bill attached to the invoice.
- 6.4 Return of Unacceptable Items:** If the Agency deems the Contract Items to be unacceptable, the Contract Items shall be returned to Vendor at Vendor's expense and with no restocking charge. Vendor shall either make arrangements for the return within five (5) days of being notified that items are unacceptable, or permit the Agency to arrange for the return and reimburse Agency for delivery expenses. If the original packaging cannot be utilized for the return, Vendor will supply the Agency with appropriate return packaging upon request. All returns of unacceptable items shall be F.O.B. the Agency's location. The returned product shall either be replaced, or the Agency shall receive a full credit or refund for the purchase price, at the

- 6.5 Return Due to Agency Error:** Items ordered in error by the Agency will be returned for credit within 30 days of receipt, F.O.B. Vendor's location. Vendor shall not charge a restocking fee if returned products are in a resalable condition. Items shall be deemed to be in a resalable condition if they are unused and in the original packaging. Any restocking fee for items not in a resalable condition shall be the lower of the Vendor's customary restocking fee or 5% of the total invoiced value of the returned items.

**7. VENDOR DEFAULT:**

- 7.1** The following shall be considered a vendor default under this Contract.



# PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

**CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code § 5-22-1(i), the contracting public entity shall not award a construction contract to any bidder that is known to be in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, including, but not limited to, obligations related to payroll taxes, property taxes, sales and use taxes, fire service fees, or other fines or fees.

**ALL CONTRACTS:** Under W. Va. Code §5A-3-10a, no contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and: (1) the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate; or (2) the debtor is in employer default.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition listed above does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of the W. Va. Code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

**DEFINITIONS:**

**"Debt"** means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

**"Employer default"** means having an outstanding balance or liability to the old fund or to the uninsured employers' fund or being in policy default, as defined in W. Va. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

**"Related party"** means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

**AFFIRMATION:** By signing this form, the vendor's authorized signer affirms and acknowledges under penalty of law for false swearing (W. Va. Code §61-5-3) that: (1) for construction contracts, the vendor is not in default on any monetary obligation owed to the state or a political subdivision of the state, and (2) for all other contracts, that neither vendor nor any related party owe a debt as defined above and that neither vendor nor any related party are in employer default as defined above, unless the debt or employer default is permitted under the exception above.

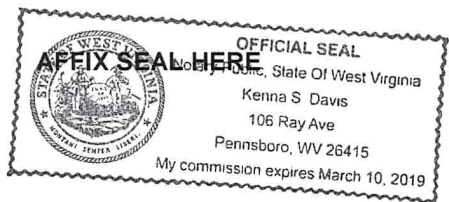
