2015 WEST VIRGINIA BIG BUCK CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

The West Virginia Big Buck Contest was established in 1964 to recognize hunters who harvested extraordinarily large-antlered bucks. Although the contest was discontinued in 2013, the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources continues to score deer as part of their Big Buck Certification Program. This program is co-sponsored by the Division of Natural Resources, the Izaak Walton League of West Virginia, the West Virginia Bowhunter's Association, the West Virginia Muzzleloader's Association, the Physically Challenged Advisory Board, and Toyota.

The Boone and Crockett Club or Pope and Young Club scoring system is used to score each buck, depending on method of kill. Guidelines for the certification program are as follows:

- 1. The deer must have been checked at an Official Game Checking Station, and the official West Virginia Game Check Tag must be attached to the antlers. Beginning in 2015, deer must be checked electronically and the DNR-issued game tag confirmation number must be written on a tag and attached to the antlers.
- 2. To be eligible, the buck must have been scored by an Official Scorer approved by Boone and Crockett or Pope and Young.
- 3. To be eligible, any bow or crossbow-killed buck must score at least 125 typical or 155 non-typical. Any gun or muzzleloader-killed buck must score at least 140 typical or 165 non-typical.
- 4. A Fair Chase Affidavit must be signed and attached to the Official Score Sheet.
- 5. For state record entries, field photos of the freshly killed deer (antlers attached) must be submitted at the time of scoring.

In 2015, 169 hunters had their deer scored at one of six WVDNR District Offices, a field office, or at the West Virginia Hunting and Fishing Show in Charleston (sponsored by the West Virginia Trophy Hunter's Association). There are 18 WVDNR Wildlife Biologists and Wildlife Managers throughout the state that are certified as Official Scorers by Boone and Crockett and/or Pope and Young. During the 2015 hunting season, 82 bucks (Table 1) were harvested with a gun, muzzleloader, bow, or crossbow and met minimum score requirements, as well as the other requirements listed above. An additional 12 bucks from previous years were scored and met the requirements for a Big Buck Certificate.

It is noteworthy that 3 score sheets met minimum score requirements but did not have a Game Check Tag verified, or did not have a signed Fair Chase Affidavit attached. These are common reasons why a hunter's buck gets excluded from the certification list and does not warrant a Big Buck Certificate. A good practice is to record the DNR-issued game tag confirmation number on the back of a mounted head so that it is not misplaced. A hunter may only take their buck to be scored by one Official Scorer. "Score shopping" is prohibited by the Big Buck Certification Program and will be dealt with in accordance with policies set forth by Boone and Crockett and/or Pope and Young. It is the hunter's responsibility to work with their Official Scorer to ensure that all documentation is completed and sent to the Big Buck

Certification Program Coordinator by March 15th following the year in which the buck was harvested.

The WV Big Buck Certification Program Coordinator would like to congratulate all hunters whom harvested bucks that qualified for a certificate this year. In addition, a special thanks to all hunters who participated and had their deer scored this year!
