Materials Needed:

- Large sheet of paper or poster board
- Writing utensils

Instructions:

A new zoo has recently opened at the North Pole, but there has been complaints about there being a limited number of species available on exhibit. The owner of the zoo has decided to introduce orangutans to their collection of animals. They have hired you to design an enclosure for orangutans with no budget (go crazy!). It must include a water source, a way to feed the animals, clean their exhibit (safely), and it must include interactive activities and obstacles for the orangutans, as well as safety precautions to keep the animals contained and the zookeepers safe, etc.

1. Do some research about the species
2. Design the enclosure for orangutans on your poster board or large sheet of paper.
3. Make sure to include everything that the species needs to survive through a life at the North Pole.
4. Cover the pinecone with peanut butter.
5. Coat the pinecone with peanut butter with birdseed.
6. Hang somewhere that is sheltered from rain, a tree with a strong canopy, or under a patio roof.
