The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is soliciting comments concerning the 2021-2022 big game hunting regulations; 2022-2023 hunting and trapping regulations and 2022 fishing regulations. Regulation meetings originally scheduled for March 15 and 16, 2021 have been cancelled due to concerns relating to the Covid-19 pandemic. # THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF NATURAL RESOURCES HAS REQUESTED YOUR OPINION ON THE FOLLOWING REGULATION PROPOSAL:

The Little Canaan Wildlife Management Area, Canaan Valley National Wildlife Refuge and Calvin Price State Forest would be closed for the two-week buck firearms season and the concurrent antlerless deer firearms season. During this period the archery and crossbow seasons would remain open for deer. An early 1-week either-sex muzzleloader deer season will be held-timing to be determined. The annual antlered deer bag limit on each of these areas would be one deer for all deer seasons combined. Antlered deer taken on these areas would be required to have a minimum outside antler spread of 14 inches (ear tip to ear tip).
