We, the undersigned, having examined the site and being familiar with the local conditions affecting the cost of the work and also being familiar with the general conditions to vendors, drawings, and specifications, hereby proposes to furnish all materials, equipment, and labor to complete all work in a workmanlike manner, as described in the Bidding documents.

Base Bid

The Base Bid shall consist of the one-time purchase of materials and services for the renovation of a storage building. This includes the installation of three 10'x10' garage doors (approximate size – contractor must measure and verify actual sizes). Garage door installations also includes all labor and materials required for framing, new vented soffit, metal-wrapped fascia, gutters, downspouts, a passage way door and a window (door and window provided by the WVDNR), Tyvek house wrap (or approved equivalent), metal siding on an approximate 26'x70' storage building, and purchase/installation of six 4-ft LED shop lights, at the Neola Wildlife Management Area, Greenbrier County, WV. The project also includes the construction of a pole-shed extension on the back of the building, approximately 16-ft deep, and including five 10-ft wide bays, with an 8-ft vertical clearance at the entry-ways. The extension will be roofed with matching metal roofing panels, enclosed on two sides, and open on the front. It will receive aluminum-wrapped fascia, gutters, and downspouts. The project includes the removal and proper disposal of all discarded building debris (doors, windows, plywood, etc.), and includes all incidental labor and materials. The total of all items shall be summarized as the Total Base Bid in the space indicated below.



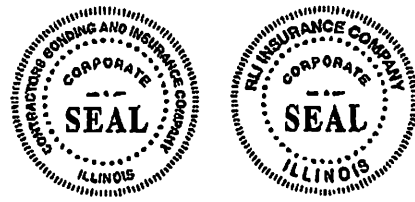

1. CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: W. Va. Code § 21-11-2 requires that all persons desiring to perform contracting work in this state be licensed. The West Virginia Contractors Licensing Board is empowered to issue the contractor's license. Applications for a contractor's license may be made by contacting the West Virginia Division of Labor. W. Va. Code § 21-11-11 requires any prospective Vendor to include the contractor's license number on its bid. If an apparent low bidder fails to submit a license number in accordance with this section, the Property and Procurement Office will promptly request by telephone and electronic mail that the low bidder and the second low bidder provide the license number within one business day of the request. Failure of the bidder to provide the license number within one business day of receiving the request shall result in disqualification of the bid. Code § 23-2c-2, failure to maintain mandatory workers' compensation coverage, or failure to fully meet its obligations as a workers' compensation self-insured employer. An employer is not in employer default if it has entered into a repayment agreement with the Insurance Commissioner and remains in compliance with the obligations under the repayment agreement.

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

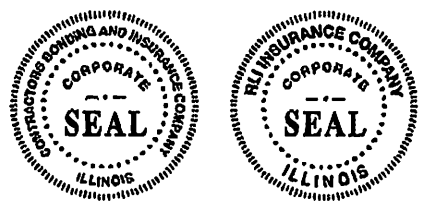
