-Animal Tracks-

Materials Needed:

- Animal track pintables (below)
- Paper
- Writing utensil
- Play-doh

Instructions:

- 1. Pick a species of animal from the list, WV Species, have the students draw what they think the animal's print will look like on their piece of paper.
- 2. After, go over with them the different types of tracks from WV Species.
- 3. Compare the track they have drawn to the actual track. What is different? What did you not notice before?
- 4. Let the students use the Play-Doh to make their own track impression, they can try to duplicate an animal's track, or they can make their own mark.
- 5. Optional: Take them on a hike, around the yard, or along a creek bank and try to find animal tracks or other signs of wildlife.
