NASP Rule Change for 2015 Tournaments

Every archer must attend a public, private, or home school offering NASP curriculum during <u>standard school hours</u>.

- After-school only archery programs or clubs are ineligible.
- The school principal's name & telephone number will be provided during registration.
- NASP may choose to contact the principal to confirm

Please make sure your school is in compliance with this rule and teaching NASP during your school day!

2015 WV State Qualifying Virtual Tournament

Schools wishing to participate in the 2015 State Archery in the Schools Tournament must participate in the State Qualifying Virtual Tournament. Schools may participate in the State Virtual Tournament by either shooting with at least one other school or hosting a tournament in your own school and use the letter of score verification from the Principal. Schools must register online at

www.nasptournaments.org.

You will need to create a username and password. (May want to keep record of this because it is needed each time you login.) If you need assistance, please use the help link on the website.

Coaches may enter as many students as they like to participate in the State Qualifying Virtual Tournaments. Teams may be up to 24 and everyone else would be entered as an individual.

The State Qualifying Virtual Tournament is open now until March 3, 2015. Scores will be finalized and posted by March 5th close of business.

The Top 6 teams, Top 15 Males, and Top 15 Females (that are not already on a team) per age division will qualify to participate in the 2015 WV Archery in the Schools State Tournament

March 29, 2014 at the Charleston Civic Center. Additional teams and individuals may qualify for the State Tournament and would be contacted by the Krista Snodgrass, Program Coordinator.

10th Annual West Virginia State Archery in the Schools Tournament

The WV DNR will host the 10th Annual WV State Archery in the Schools Tournament March 28, 2015 at the Charleston Civic Center.

Schools that qualify through the State Qualifying Virtual Tournament will compete to be the top Archery in the Schools teams and individuals in the state.

Teams sizes may be up to 24

shooters and must have 4 of the opposite gender. The Top 12 shooters and at least 4 being of the opposite gender will be used to determine winners.

First place teams in each division are automatically qualified to attend the 2015 NASP Nationals May 7-9, 2015 at the Kentucky Exposition Center.

Additional teams may attend with qualifying team scores.

1st-5th place male and females, 1st- 5th individual winners in the Elementary School, Middle School and High School Divisions qualify to attend.

Specific information on the State Tournament (rules, shooting times, etc.) is posted on the WV DNR website. Also all those that qualify will be contacted on March 3, 2015.
